Recommendations for the replacement of individual damaged BritLock Slates

- Carefully remove remains of damaged slate and fixing nails. If necessary saw off the nails flush with the slate battens.
- 2. Apply continuous bead of adhesive to top interlock of replacement BritLock slate, across full width of slate. Suitable adhesive can be obtained from local roofing or builders merchants.
- 3. Apply continuous bead adhesive to side interlock of replacement BritLock slate, along full length of slate.
- Carefully insert replacement BritLock slate into roofing, pressing surrounding slates onto adhesive.
- 5. Drill a hole through the tail of the replacement slate, passing through the head of the slate below and into the timber batten of the slate below. Secure replacement slate using a 45 x 4mm long stainless steel screw and sealing washer.

Note: The above recommendations are for replacing individual BritLock slates only. All surrounding BritLock slates must be correctly fixed in accordance with the usual Manufacturers' recommendations.
